## REAR ADMIRAL J P BARKER

*Rear Admiral John BARKER is aged 52 and was educated at the Nautical College Pangbourne.*

*He joined the Royal Navy as a Special Entry Cadet in 1948 and after service in various ships (including HMS KING GEORGE V) as a Midshipman, he joined the staff of the Commander-in-Chief Home Fleet in HMS INDOMITABLE (and later HMS VANGUARD) in 1951 as a Lieutenant. After serving on the staff of the Commander-in-Chief, The Nore, from 1953-55, he was the Captain's Secretary at HMS CERES, in Wetherby, Yorkshire, from 1955-57. Returning to sea in 1957, he was the Supply Officer of HMS LAGOS and then went to BRNC Dartmouth from 1958-1961. After the Supply and Secretariat Advanced Course in 1961, he went as Secretary to the Chief of Staff to the Commander, British Navy Staff, Washington. In 1964 he joined the Ministry of Defence (Navy) as Secretary to the Assistant Chief of Naval Staff (Warfare) and was promoted to Commander in June 1967. He served as Supply Officer of HMS HAMPSHIRE from 1967 to 1968, and was appointed as Secretary to the Flag Officer Second in Command, Far East Fleet. In 1969 he became Secretary to the Flag Officer Plymouth, and then Executive Officer of HMS CENTURION from 1971-72. In mid 1972 he was appointed Secretary to the Controller of the Navy in the Ministry of Defence (Navy) until March 1976. After working on two working parties for the Controller of the Navy, he was a student on the 1977 RCDS Course. From 1978 until April 1980, he was the Director of Fleet Supply Duties in the Ministry.*

*From May 1980 to March 1983 he commanded HMS CENTURION, the pay, drafting and records establishment. Promoted Rear Admiral in April 1983 when he became the Chief of Staff to Commander-in-Chief Naval Home Command.*

*Rear Admiral BARKER is married and has lived in Lee-on-Solent since 1966. He has two sons.*

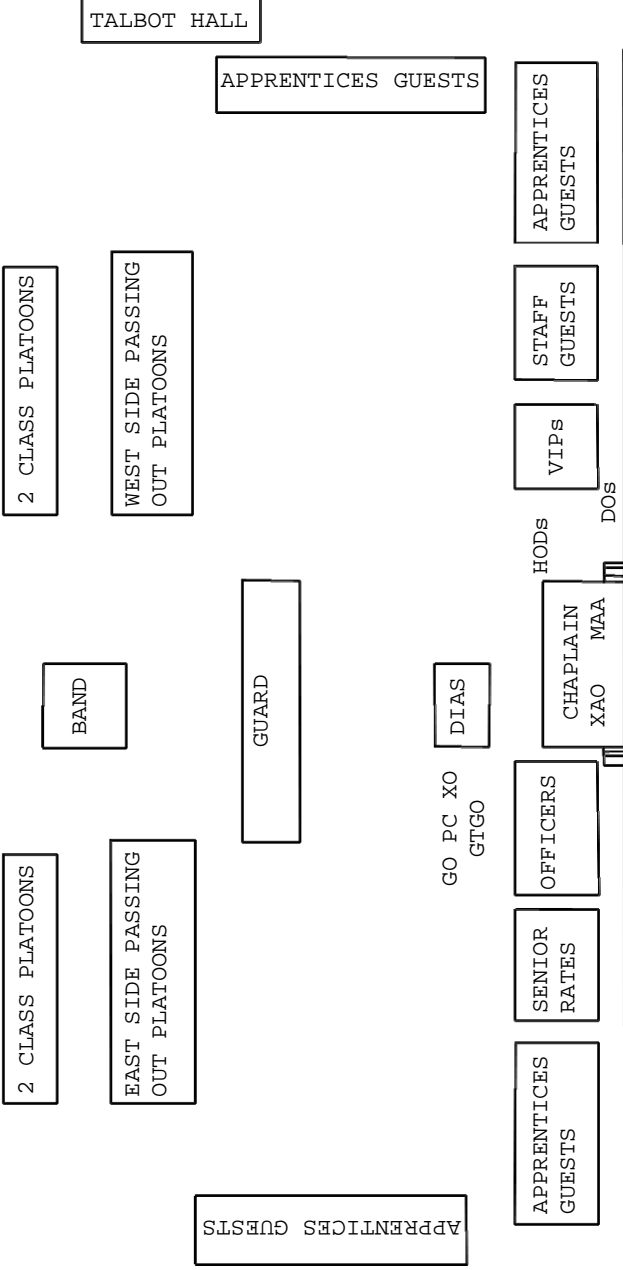

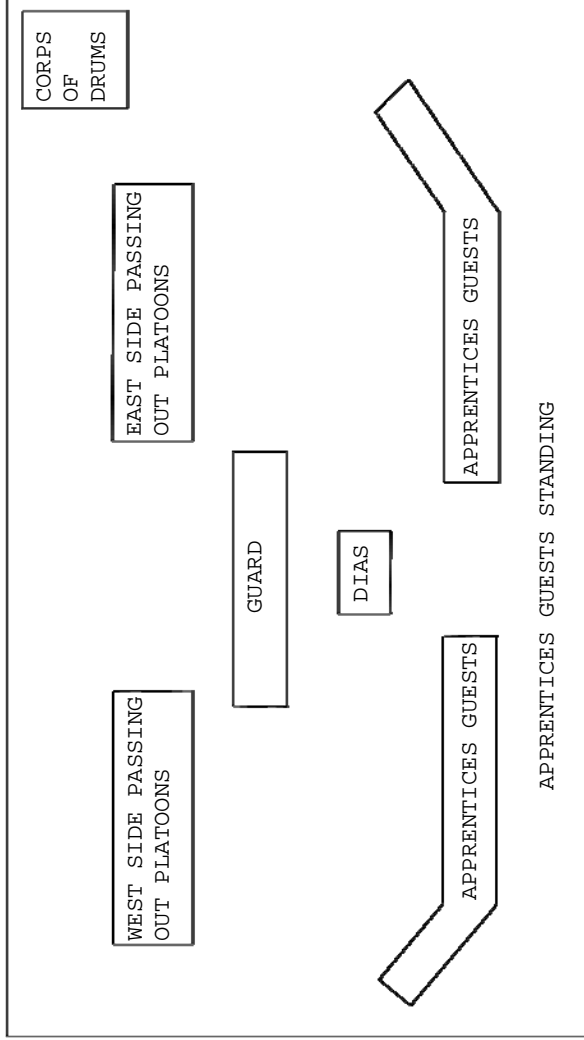

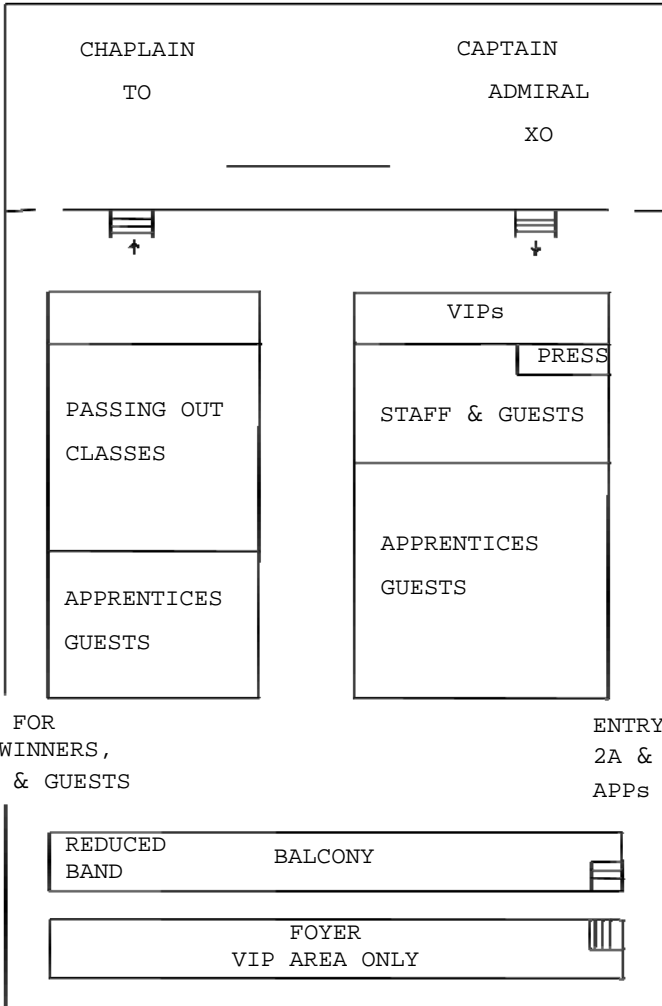
